The 4"T's" of Stewardship: Transformation



The second "T" in our Stewardship theme is Transformation. Our scripture for this week is; Romans 12: 1-2, 9-21. While previous chapters in Romans have been primarily focused on theological discussion and instruction to congregations;

beginning in Chapter 12 Paul addresses what it means for individuals to live a holy life. This chapter is full of practical suggestions for ways to transform into a person whose life mirrors the life of Jesus Christ. In the first 2 verses Paul states very clearly that we are to be transformed by renewing our minds. Every day Christians must choose to make the sacrifices necessary to follow Jesus and worship God.

Every day our society sends us messages that contradict everything Jesus teaches. Advertisers would ask us to believe all that you need to transform into someone popular, wealthy and powerful are the latest fashion in clothes, a bigger house in the suburbs, a better haircut, influential friends and a high-power job.

This Sunday, November 9th we will look at the list of practical guidelines Paul provides in verse 9-21 on how Christians should act in order to set our minds on the priorities of Christian living. Paul's suggestions provide a measuring stick that helps us grow and mature in our Christian behavior. We will be invited to look over that list of guidelines and choose one behavior we think might be improved in ourselves. We will jot that on the card provided and attach it to the



cross up front. Making a prayerful covenant with God to work on transforming to be more like Jesus.







