The 4"T's" of Stewardship: Thanksgiving



Thanksgiving Sunday is November 23. It will be a very special day because it is our opportunity to put into writing our promise to support the church with our financial resources. We will also be celebrating Thanksgiving in scripture and sermon and with a fabulous Thanksgiving dinner following worship.

Our scripture for Sunday is a well-known Psalm—Psalm 100. This Psalm is just 5 verses of pure joy. Biblical scholars assume it was a song used for processionals in worship. There was a beautiful hymn written for Queen Elizabeth's coronation in 1956 based on the Psalm. We know it as the tune to; Praise God from Whom All Blessings Flow.

The author of the Psalm calls worshipper to enter the sanctuary with joyous, boisterous, celebrative singing. Not adverbs we would generally use for singing in worship in the 21st century white congregations. We tend to delegate that to the children's choir. Maybe this Sunday we will practice worshipping with joy and thanksgiving.





