Calling All Disciples!



On Sunday, January 18 our scripture lesson is John 1: 29-42. The author of John gives us the story of 2 key moments in Jesus' life; his baptism and the call of the first disciples. Last Sunday, our guest preacher, Tammy Tychsen gave some very helpful insights on Jesus' baptism according to the Gospel of Matthew.

Just as it is helpful to get more than one accounting of any event in order to get the whole picture; the same is true of the Gospel accounts of Jesus' ministry. New Testament scholar, Sandra M. Schneiders understands John's account not to be a description of the actual event but rather a focus on the signs that might lead others to belief in Jesus as the Son of God. Perhaps the author assumed his readers already knew the Jesus story. Remember, the Gospel of John was written later than the other Gospels and some of Paul's letters.

Our primary focus on Sunday will be upon John's story of the calling of the first Disciples and our calling to come to Jesus. Just as Jesus invites Andrew "Come and see." Jesus invites us to come and see and know Jesus as our Savior. I look forward to worshiping with you Sunday.

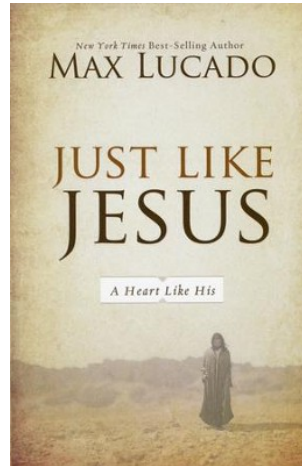
